## **DECISION**

I have today decided to disclose the located information to you in full.

Please find attached information pursuant to your request.

Please note that the answer to question 1 can be found within the spreadsheet titled 'Corrosive Fluid Report - May 2018'. Please refer to the data within the 'violent offences' columns of this spreadsheet. The answer to question 2 is provided within the spreadsheet titled 'Corrosive Fluid Report - Mopeds'.

## **CONTEXT**

What is the Met doing to tackle it?

- The MPS is delivering a London-wide strategy to tackle threats of, and physical assault with corrosive substances. It is also linked in to the Home Office, Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime (MOPAC) and the National Police Chiefs Council strategies to ensure matters of regulation, legislation and policy are raised at the highest levels of government.
- It is targeting offenders through intelligence analyses and has helped form a new service level agreement with the Crown Prosecution Service to increase the number of offenders being charged and convicted for

carrying corrosive liquids. This will be further supported on the introduction of the new Weapons Bill going through government.

- All of the Met's emergency police vehicles across London have been equipped with treatment kits (these include protective eyewear and gauntlets for corrosive injuries and 5 litre bottles of water) and all of its officers are receiving extra emergency life support training to help victims who have been physically attacked and give them first aid, which can be crucial to limiting injuries.
- It has introduced a new joint control room protocol with the London Fire Brigade, which has enabled improvements to our combined response at crime scenes, reducing the severity of injuries to victims through enhanced first aid options.

Detective Superintendent Mike West, Metropolitan Police Service, said:

“We will not tolerate any violent attack of any kind, including those using corrosive substance, which we treat these with an equal response to that of knife and gun crime and are determined to bring those who do to justice.

“When a person receives injuries from corrosive substances, it is imperative that the injuries are treated as soon as possible by pouring water over the wounds. The best way to administer water to the injury is by a long continuous flow rather than simply pouring water over a victim (this of course may not be possible at the time so just administer water as it comes and keep doing it).

“We are working across London, and with national partners, to tackle these crimes including targeting offenders through analysing intelligence, working with retailers to reduce the sales of these substances to under 18s and advancements in our street testing kits.

“We also hold immersive events which raise awareness for businesses, licensees and nightclubs of acid attacks and prepare them to deal with any type of attack of this nature should it happen on their premises.

“Whilst the scale of attacks has reduced and are not an everyday occurrence in London, it is very important that we are all prepared in the event that one does happen and we do the best for any victims of this type of crime. Training and awareness events like today are so important to prove that we are all working together to tackle this problem in a really robust way across the capital and across the UK.”

# Violent Corrosive Liquid Offences since 2002 \*



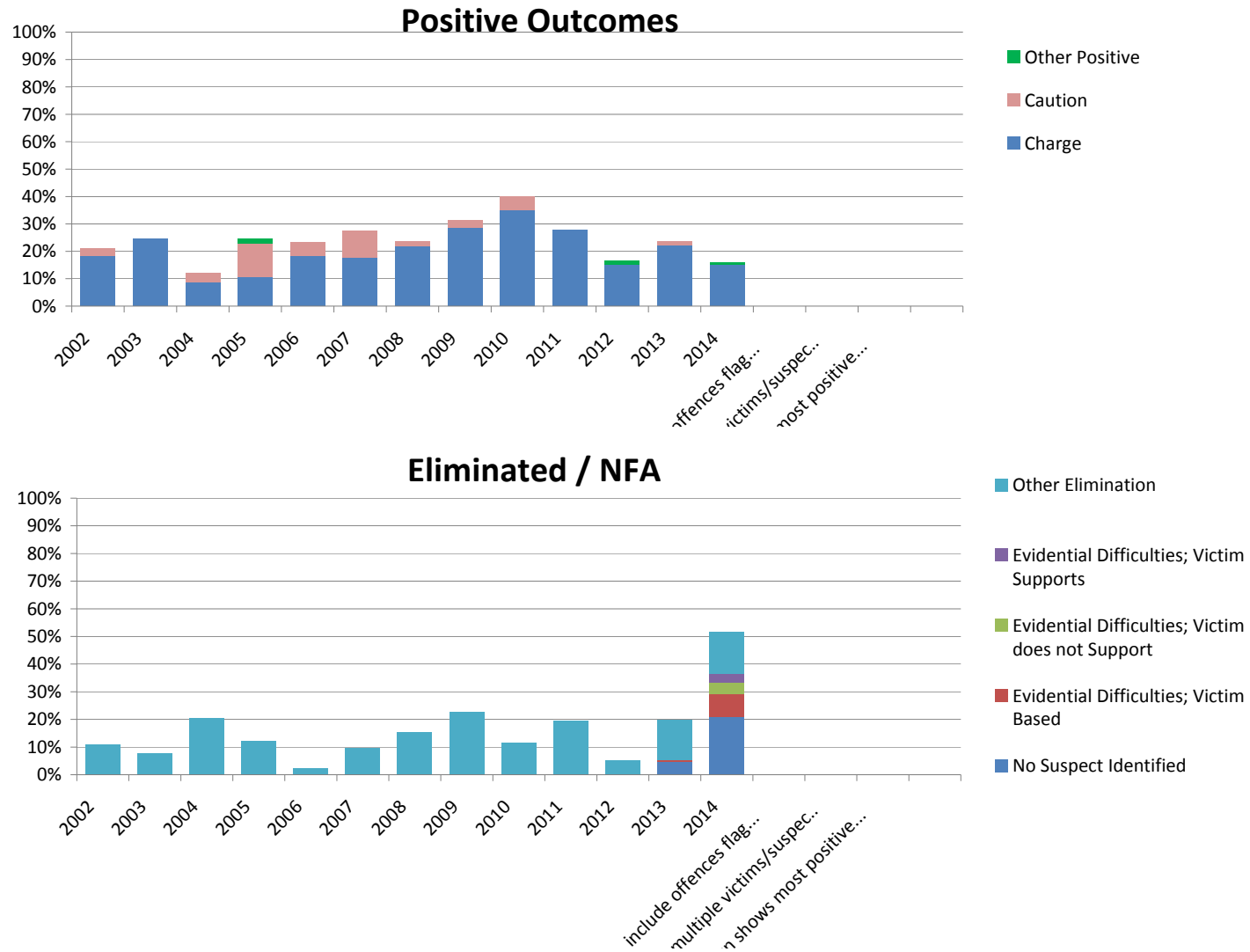
