

Notice for hearing to be held in public 21st – 24th January 2019

Police Sergeant Martin Lowrie based at Central East Command Unit - CE, will answer allegations that his conduct amounts to a breach of Standards of Professional Behaviour, in respect of:

Authority, Respect and Courtesy, Honesty & Integrity and Discreditable Conduct.

It is alleged that on 5th April 2017 at approximately 10pm PS Lowrie was off duty at home when his neighbour's knocked on his front door to ask him to desist from making excessive noise. In response, PS Lowrie has used verbally abusive language towards them.

It is also alleged that PS Lowrie later provided a copy of a CCTV recording of the incident which he had edited or caused to be edited.

It is alleged that in doing so PS Lowrie breached the Standards of Professional Behaviour in respect of:

Authority, Respect and Courtesy, Honesty & Integrity and Discreditable Conduct.

The hearing will start on Monday 21st January 2019 and is listed for four days.

The hearing will start at 0930 hours and will be held in the hearing room, 14th floor, Empress State Building, Lillie Road, SW6 1TR

The identity of victims/witnesses will be protected during the hearing as appropriate.
