

Notice for a misconduct hearing to be held in public on 17th and 18th September 2019

Former Trainee Detective Constable Andrianas Nikolajevs, based at JC (Waltham Forest), will answer allegations that his conduct amounted to a breach of the Standards of Professional Behaviour in respect of:

**Authority, Respect and Courtesy;
Honesty and Integrity; and
Discreditable Conduct.**

On 26th May 2018, former T/DC Nikolajevs was on duty at Waltham Forest Custody Centre.

During his shift, former T/DC Nikolajevs had cause to interview a detainee (Female A).

Female A was later released from custody without charge, however it is alleged that following her release, former T/DC Nikolajevs engaged in, or sought to engage in an inappropriate relationship with her.

It is alleged that, through his actions, former T/DC Nikolajevs breached the Standards of Professional Behaviour in respect of Authority, Respect and Courtesy, Honesty and Integrity and Discreditable Conduct.

Former T/DC Nikolajevs resigned from the Metropolitan Police Service on 1st October 2018.

Reporting restrictions are in place in relation to this hearing. No person attending the hearing shall publish, communicate or otherwise disseminate the name and address of Female A or any information that might lead to the identification of Female A.

The hearing is scheduled to start on Tuesday 17th September 2019 and is listed for two days.

It will be held from 0930 hours in the DPS Tribunal Rooms, 14th Floor, Empress State Building, Lillie Road, SW6 1TR.
